

Ways to GET Involved 2017 Auction

Donation Solicitation Committee (MOST HELP NEEDED HERE)

- Assist the Solicitation Team in contacting past and prospective donors.
- Help in gathering donations and listing the values, contact person, and any restrictions a donation may have.
- Soliciting as little as 3-5 donations can be a huge help!
- Time Commitment: Flexible 1-10 hours

Sponsorship Solicitation Committee

- Assist the Sponsorship Team in contacting past and prospective sponsors.
- Are you connected to a few parents or businesses who would potentially sponsor a table at the auction? A few phone calls to your social and professional network are very valuable to us! Also, these connections may be the right source for a unique silent or live auction package.
- Time Commitment: Flexible 1-3 hours

Class Basket/Wrapping Committee

- Lead or assist in the effort to get class baskets. Work with room parents to communicate goal and timing.
- Lead or assist in the wrapping and collection of baskets. Rhonda Schafer will be your mentor.
- Time Commitment: Flexible 3-5 hours
